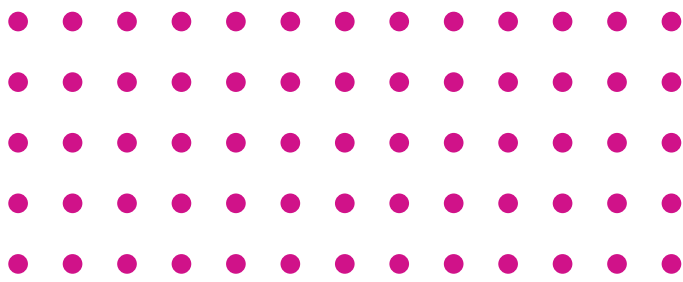

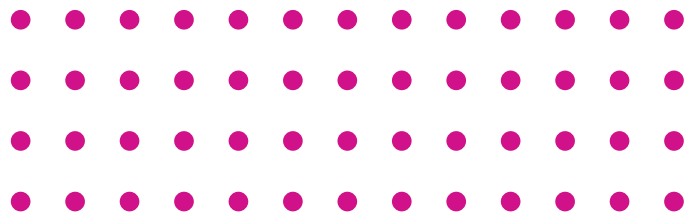

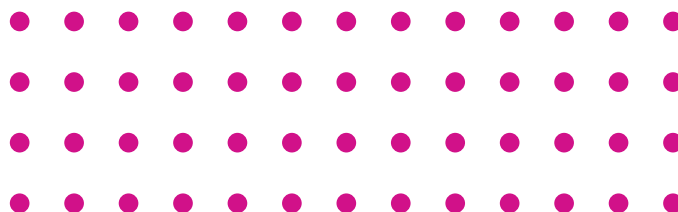


## WHO SHOULD TAKE THIS CLASS AND WHAT IS THE TIME COMMITMENT?

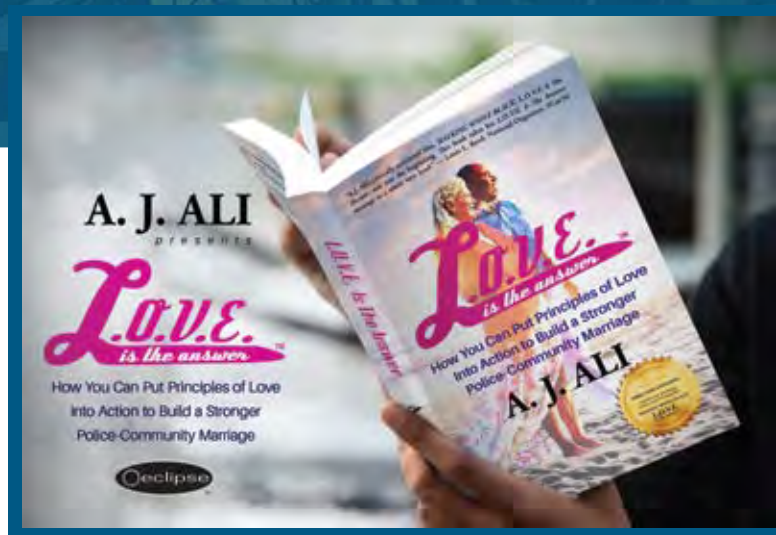

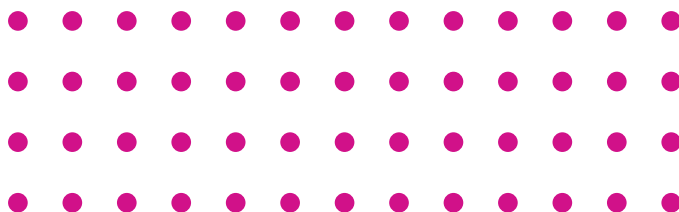

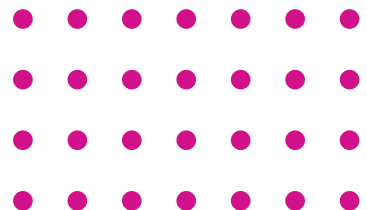
